Heart of Arkansas Welcomes AirPower Arkansas 2008

Central Arkansas anticipates exciting air show at LRAFB

LITTLE ROCK, AR (Wednesday, September 24, 2008) – AirPower Arkansas 2008 will present the Little Rock Air Force Base Air Show and Open House on October 18-19, 2008. This year's event will feature the Navy's Blue Angels and the Army's Golden Knights aerial demonstration teams in addition to dozens of other attractions at the LRAFB in Jacksonville.

Not since 2006 has a show of this caliber been hosted in Arkansas, so it will be a Must See for central Arkansas residents. Over 200,000 people are expected to be in attendance to marvel at the aerial acrobatic skills of the Blue Angels as they perform high precision maneuvers in air-tight formations. Performing before over 414 million fans since its inception in 1946, the Blue Angels' demonstration is guaranteed to impress any crowd. In addition the Army's Golden Knights are expected to wow the crowd with their skydiving moves.

A Viper West F-16 Demonstration, the Shockwave Jet Truck and Fat Albert, a C-130 that takes off in less than 1,500 feet and flies at a 45 degree angle to an altitude of 1,000 feet in approximately 15 seconds with the assistance of eight solid-fuel rocket bottles in their Jet Assisted Take Off demonstration, are among the many attractions available at this year's event.
